RESOLUTION TO AMEND AND APPROVE VIRIGNIA TECH UNDERGRADUATE HOUSING POLICY

WHEREAS, Virginia Tech's housing policy states, "All first-year (undergraduate) students are required to live on campus (in Blacksburg), are guaranteed housing, and must have a dining plan," and

WHEREAS, Virginia Tech is dedicted to offering excellent, on-campus, residential experiences for all incoming first-year students; and

WHEREAS, the university will continue to require that first-year undergraduate students live in residence halls on the Blacksburg campus; and

WHEREAS, amending the undergraduate housing policy will improve the university's ability to provide on-campus residential experiences for first-year students; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, an unexpected surplus of students applied for on-campus housing, and in compliance with current policy that guarantees housing for first year students, the university was obligated to secure hotels, impacting the experience of entering first-year students; and

WHEREAS, suspending the requirement to live on campus and guarantee of housing for students who submit a housing contract after on-campus capacity is exhausted does not preclude the university from considering options for securing additional housing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the policy language noted below be approved and made effective upon approval by the Board of Visitors; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriate university documents and websites include the revised policy language; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Board of Visitors delegates changes to this policy to the president and the president's designee.

Virginia Tech Undergraduate Housing Policy

All first-year students are required to live on campus, are guaranteed housing, and must have a dining plan.

Virginia Tech maintains a first-year housing and dining plan requirement with the goal of accommodating all first-year students. Virginia Tech may, on occasion, suspend the first-year requirement and guarantee for those who do not to submit their housing contract before the university's on-camus housing capacity in Blacksburg has been exhausted. First-year students should submit a housing contract as soon as they are committed to attending Virginia Tech.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Visitors approve the amended housing policy for undergraduate students.
