

**RESOLUTION ON APPOINTMENT TO THE
NEW RIVER VALLEY REGIONAL WATER AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the New River Valley Regional Water Authority (Authority) consists of five members who are responsible for the management and operation of the Authority – each of the political subdivisions have the right to appoint one member, and one at-large member is appointed jointly by the Virginia Tech Board of Visitors, the Blacksburg and Christiansburg Town Councils, and the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, one director is appointed by each of the political subdivisions, and the other member is appointed jointly by the political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Visitors approved the appointment of Christopher H. Kiwus, Associate Vice President and Chief Facilities Officer, as the university’s representative to the Authority on November 18, 2019, effective December 1, 2019 and to complete the appointment term expiring June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the university desires to reappoint Christopher H. Kiwus, Associate Vice President and Chief Facilities Officer, as the university’s representative to the Authority for a four-year term expiring June 30, 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Christopher H. Kiwus, Associate Vice President and Chief Facilities Officer, be reappointed as the university’s representative to the New River Valley Regional Water Authority for a four-year term expiring June 30, 2024.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the above resolution reappointing Christopher H. Kiwus, Associate Vice President and Chief Facilities Officer, as the university’s representative to the New River Valley Regional Water Authority through June 30, 2024 be approved.
