RESOLUTION MANDATING THAT FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS RECEIVE AND COMPLETE HUMAN TRAFFICKING TRAINING

WHEREAS, the Virginia General Assembly has adopted §23.1-808.1, Code of Virginia, which requires public institutions of higher education to provide human trafficking awareness and prevention training to all first-year students as part of the institution's first-year orientation program, effective July 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, providing human trafficking awareness and prevention training to students can help prevent the occurrence of trafficking and aid in the recognition and reporting of potential trafficking situations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Visitors endorses a policy of including human trafficking awareness and prevention training to the first-year student orientation program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Virginia Tech Board of Visitors mandates as policy that all first-year students be provided and complete traumainformed training on human trafficking awareness and prevention training as part of the first-year orientation program, effective July 1, 2023.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the resolution mandating that all first-year students be provided and complete trauma-informed training on human trafficking awareness and prevention as part of the first-year student orientation program be approved, effective July 1, 2023.

ATTACHMENT S VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY -- 2023 SESSION

CHAPTER 30

An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 23.1 a section numbered 23.1-808.1, relating to institutions of higher education; human trafficking awareness and prevention training required.

Approved March 17, 2023

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 23.1 a section numbered 23.1-808.1 as follows:

§ 23.1-808.1. Human trafficking awareness and prevention training; first-year orientation.

A. The governing board of each public institution of higher education shall develop and implement policies requiring that a human trafficking awareness and prevention training program be provided to and completed by all first-year students as a part of such institution's first-year orientation program. Such training program shall include trauma-informed training on the recognition, prevention, and reporting of human trafficking.

B. The Council shall encourage private institutions of higher education to develop and implement policies to provide such a human trafficking awareness and prevention training program as a part of their first-year orientation programs.
