

**RESOLUTION ON APPOINTMENT TO THE
NEW RIVER VALLEY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS REGIONAL AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the New River Valley Emergency Communications Regional Authority (the Authority) consists of five members who are responsible for the management and operation of the Authority – each of the political subdivisions have the right to appoint one member, and one at-large member is appointed jointly by the Virginia Tech Board of Visitors, the Blacksburg and Christiansburg Town Councils, and the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Visitors approved the appointment of Lynsay M. Belshe, Vice President for Auxiliary and Business Services, as the university's representative to the Authority, effective June 1, 2021, to complete the current four-year term expiring August 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Virginia Tech desires to appoint Michael J. Mulhare, interim Associate Vice President for Public Safety, as the university's representative to the Authority, effective June 1, 2023, to complete the current four-year term expiring August 31, 2023;

WHEREAS, Virginia Tech desires to appoint Michael J. Mulhare, as the Virginia Tech representative for a four-year term beginning September 1, 2023 expiring August 31, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Michael J. Mulhare, interim Associate Vice President for Public Safety, be appointed as the university's representative to and member on the New River Valley Emergency Communications Regional Authority effective June 1, 2023 expiring August 31, 2027.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the resolution recommending that Michael J. Mulhare, interim Associate Vice President for Public Safety, be appointed as the university's representative to the New River Valley Emergency Communications Regional Authority Board of Directors be approved.
