RESOLUTION REGARDING PRE-ENROLLMENT COURSES

WHEREAS, Virginia Tech has developed non-credit online pre-enrollment programs that admitted students are expected to complete; and

WHEREAS, these programs have been designed to teach students about the University's values and expectations; and

WHEREAS, it is the expectation that these programs be completed before an undergraduate, transfer student, graduate, or professional student begins studying at Virginia Tech so that all students have a common understanding of Virginia Tech's core values; and

WHEREAS, to recognize the importance of these programs students should be blocked from continued enrollment until the courses are complete.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Visitors delegates its authority to the president or the president's designee for placing a hold on a student's ability to register for credit-bearing classes when said student does not complete those pre-enrollment programs designated as required.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Visitors pass the above resolution.
