

**RESOLUTION ON APPOINTMENT TO THE
MONTGOMERY REGIONAL SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the Montgomery Regional Solid Waste Authority consists of five directors who are responsible for the management and operation of the Authority; and,

WHEREAS, one director is appointed by each of the political subdivisions, and one at-large director is appointed jointly by the Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University Board of Visitors, the Blacksburg and Christiansburg Town Councils, and the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Visitors approved the appointment Mark S. Helms, Director of Facilities Operations, as the university's representative to the Authority on June 2, 2014 to serve for a term expiring June 30, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, Mark S. Helms retired from Virginia Tech effective August 31, 2016 and is no longer serving as Director of Facilities Operations; and,

WHEREAS, Virginia Tech desires to appoint the Associate Vice President and Chief Facilities Officer as the university's representative to serve the remainder of the four-year term;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Christopher H. Kiwus, Associate Vice President and Chief Facilities Officer, be named as the university's representative to and member of the Montgomery Regional Solid Waste Authority, retroactive to September 1, 2016, for a term expiring June 30, 2018.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the above resolution recommending Christopher H. Kiwus, Associate Vice President and Chief Facilities Officer, be appointed as the university's representative to the Montgomery Regional Solid Waste Authority Board of Directors be approved.
